- Learning about Egypt's economic activity and trade, including the importance of tourism.

**In Science we will be:**

- Describing the changes as humans develop to old age.
- Identifying and naming the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describing the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.
- Recognising the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.
- Describing the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

**In Maths we will be studying:**

- Place value to a million including rounding and negative numbers.
- Number: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Statistics; reading and interpreting data using graphs and tables
- Area and perimeter

**In Art we will be:**

- Appreciating the art of the Ancient Egyptians.
- Developing our drawing skills with different mediums
- Using sculpture to create faces/heads, being inspired by the Ancient Egyptians.

**In History we will be:**

- Investigating the ancient civilisation of Egypt- comparing it to Stone Age Britain.
- Gaining an understanding of the term 'civilisation'
- Understanding the methods of historical enquiry, including how evidence is used.
- Investigating the cultural, economic, military, political, religious and social history of Ancient Egypt.

**In RE we will be:**

- Learning the creation stories from different religions.
- Learning that there are differences and similarities between religions.
- Finding out the meanings of the gospel stories in Christianity.

**In DT we will be:**

- Investigating different types of bread and evaluating different products
- Designing our own flavours
- Creating our own bread roll and evaluating our product.

**In Music we will be:**

- Playing and performing in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.
- Appreciating rock music.
- Listening with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory.

**In English we will be:**

- Reading a variety of texts including; 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo.
- Writing in a variety of forms including non-chronological reports, instructions, recounts, persuasion, narratives and poetry.
- Learning how to accurately use punctuation marks.
- Learning common spelling patterns.
- Reading to retrieve information accurately and to develop inference skills.

**In ICT we will be:**

- Looking at coding
- Learning about abstraction, decomposition, debugging and the use of inputs and outputs through creating activities.

**In PE we will be:**

- Developing our skills in leading simple games during Play leader training.
- Applying basic principles of throwing, catching, attacking and defending for use in game situations.
- Developing flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics.
- Performing dances using a range of movement patterns

**In German we will be:**

- Learning to conduct short conversations.
- Developing our vocabulary to include: days of the week, leisure activities, numbers 13-31 and family
- Learning to write simple sentences using new vocabulary.
