- Considering the importance of the River Nile to the people of Egypt and the impact of the Aswan Dam.
- Learning about Egypt's economic activity and trade, including the importance of tourism.

**In Science we will be:**

- Describing the changes as humans develop to old age.
- Identifying and naming the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describing the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.
- Recognising the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.
- Describing the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

In Maths we will be studying:

- Place value to ten million including rounding and negative numbers.
- Number: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Fractions of amounts.
- Geometry, position and direction
- Reasoning skills

In Art we will be:

- Appreciating the art of the Ancient Egyptians and discovering that this ancient art in part inspired the Art Deco movement.
- Investigate links to Cubism and Fauvism.
- Investigating Art Deco buildings and designers.

In History we will be:

- Investigating the ancient civilisation of Egypt-comparing it to Stone Age Britain.
- Gaining an understanding of the term 'civilisation'
- Understanding the methods of historical enquiry, including how evidence is used.
- Investigating the cultural, economic, military, political, religious and social history of Ancient Egypt.

In RE we will be:

- Learning what it means to be a Christian.
- Investigating different forms of Christianity.
- Learning that there are differences between different gospel accounts within the bible.
- Investigating different gospels accounts of the Christmas story.

In DT we will be:

- Designing Art Deco inspired patterns.
- Practicing different stitches.
- Selecting different stitching techniques for varying purposes.
- Using a sewing allowance.
- Creating a cushion cover.

In Music we will be:

- Developing our ability to read and write using musical notation.
- Playing and performing in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.
- Appreciating music on the theme of happiness.
- Listening with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory.

In English we will be:

- Reading a variety of texts including; 'I believe in unicorns' by Michael Morpurgo.
- Writing in a variety of forms including non-chronological reports, instructions, recounts, persuasion, narratives and poetry.
- Learning how to accurately use all punctuation marks.
- Learning common spelling patterns.
- Reading to retrieve information accurately and to develop inference skills.

In ICT we will be:

- Learning about the history of the internet.
- Understanding that the WWW and internet are not the same thing.
- Learning how search engines work.
- Discussing how we can evaluate the reliability of information found online.
- Considering how we can conduct ourselves safely and respectfully online.
- Learning about copyright laws.

In PE we will be:

- Using running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination.
- Playing competitive games including NFL and football and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending.
- Developing flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance through gymnastics.
- Performing dances using a range of movement.

In German we will be:

- Learning to understand simple instructions
- Recapping numbers and storytelling vocabulary.
- Using German vocabulary for continents.
- Understanding verbs for movement and traveling.
