

In Geography we will:

- Learning about the human and physical geography of Europe, with a focus on Italy.
- Comparing the main geographical features of Italy and the UK.
- Learn about some of the cultural aspects of modern day Italy.

In DT we will be:

- Learning about healthy balanced meals and using this knowledge to help us design and make pizzas.
- Exploring packaging options and will make sturdy well-constructed take-away boxes to take the pizzas home in.

In RE we will be:

- Learning about the different beliefs and practices of Hinduism.
- Studying religious stories and reflecting on what they tell us about the nature of God.
- Exploring how Christmas is celebrated around the world.

In English we will be:

- Reading a variety of texts including; poetry, picture books, novels and information texts
- Writing in a variety of forms including; formal and informal letters, poetry, instructions, story writing and information texts.
- Learning how to use a greater range of punctuation marks.
- Learning common spelling patterns.
- Developing a neat even, joined handwriting style.

In Art we will be:

- Learning about different techniques for creating tone and texture when drawing.
- Inspired by Ancient Rome, we will make mosaics using a variety of media.
- Studying the works of Leonardo Da Vinci.

**In Maths we will be:**

- Improving our understanding of place value.
- Using written methods for addition and subtraction calculations.
- Ensuring we know our times table facts and improving our fluency.
- Learning how to measure length accurately and be able to convert different units of length – e.g. centimetres to millimetres.

In ICT we will be:

- Ensuring we know how to log on and use the internet safely.
- Using the Paint program in Purple Mash.

In MFL we will be:

- Learning key words and phrases including; colours, foods, clothes and daily greetings.
- Writing short phrases and simple sentences.
- Learning about German traditions through singing songs, playing games and exploring their culture.

In Science we will be:

- Learning about how sounds are made.
- We will be using our investigative skills to explore patterns in pitch and volume.
- Constructing simple electrical circuits and learning about the role of each component.
- Learning about electrical conductors and insulators and how to stay safe around electricity.

In History we will be:

- Learning about the Ancient civilisation of Rome.
- Focusing on the Roman invasion and occupation of Britain and investigate the impact this had on people living here at the time.

In Music we will be:

- Learning to read simple musical notation and march rhythms and performing them on percussion instruments.
- Composing and performing our own pieces of music.
- Learning about Operatic music and how this is important to the culture of Italy.
- Learning to sing a variety of songs and perform in front of an audience for the Carol Concert.
